- 7) An electric saw cost thirty-five dollars, which is five times as much as a manual saw costs. How much does the manual saw cost?
- 8) At the ring toss booth in a carnival seven people lost and thirty-five people won. How many times as many people won as lost?
- 9) In college a math book costs five times as much as a history book. If the math book costs fifteen dollars, how much does the history book cost?
- 10) A pet store sold ten cats, which is two times as many as the number of dogs they sold. How many dogs did they sell?
- 11) At a malt shop they sold twenty-eight burgers and seven sodas. How many times as many burgers did they sell as sodas?
- 12) Henry was collecting cans for recycling. He collected seven cans on Saturday and three times that many on Sunday. How many did he collect on Sunday?
